‘Princess Ka’iulani Suite’ premieres this weekend

The Honolulu Symphony Orchestra will premiere Academy Award winner Stephen Warbeck’s “Princess Ka’iulani Suite” this weekend to celebrate Hawai’i’s 50th anniversary of statehood and the debut of the locally produced film “Barbarian Princess” at the Honolulu Film Festival.

Guest conductor Gerald Schwarz of the Seattle Symphony will lead the concerts at 8 tonight and 4 p.m. tomorrow.
